<b>Notes:</b>	<p>The analysis of a urine sample collected by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) on 5 May 2019 during an In-Competition doping control test at a Victorian Football League (VFL) match between Sandringham and Frankston at RSEA Park in Moorabbin, Victoria, detected the presence of the prohibited substance Benzoyllecgonine (metabolite of Cocaine).</p> <p>The detected substance is on the World Anti-Doping Code 2019 Prohibited List and prohibited In-Competition.</p> <p>The period of ineligibility imposed on Mr Gilbert commenced on 6 June 2019 being the date a Mandatory Provisional Suspension was imposed on him. As such, Mr Gilbert is eligible to participate in sport from 6 June 2021.</p>
