Notes:	<p>The analysis of a urine sample collected by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) on 25 May 2019 during an In-Competition doping control test at a North East Australian Football League (NEAFL) match between Gold Coast and Sydney at Metricon Stadium in Carrara, Queensland, detected the presence of the prohibited substance Benzoyllecgonine (metabolite of Cocaine).</p> <p>The detected substance is on the World Anti-Doping Code 2019 Prohibited List and prohibited In-Competition.</p> <p>The period of ineligibility imposed on Mr Crossley commenced on 28 June 2019 being the date a Mandatory Provisional Suspension was imposed on him. As such, Mr Crossley is eligible to participate in sport from 28 June 2020.</p>
