<b>Notes:</b>	<p>On 20 August 2019, Mr Rioli was subject to an out-of-competition Doping Control Test in Perth, Western Australian that subsequently returned an adverse analytical finding for use of a prohibited method, namely urine substitution.</p> <p>On 5 September 2019, Mr Rioli was subject to an in-competition Doping Control Test at an AFL Match on that day at Optus Stadium in Perth and in the course of which:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It was observed that player used a prohibited method, namely urine substitution;</li> <li>• The sample that was subsequently collected confirmed the presence of the metabolite of cannabis, which is on the World Anti-Doping Code 2019 Prohibited List and is prohibited In-Competition.</li> </ul> <p>The period of ineligibility imposed on Mr Rioli commenced 20 August 2019 being the date of the collection of the initial sample. As such, Mr Rioli is eligible to participate in sport from 20 August 2021.</p>
